This was discussed with Principal Secretary. Accordingly the strength of the restructured cadre of Orissa Service of Engineers at in different grades of the three wings i.e. Major & Medium Irrigation, Minor Irrigation and Mechanical of Water Resources Department may be fixed in the following manner.

- a) **Junior Engineers** – the number of post would be reduced by 50% as these posts would be upgraded to the level of Assistant Engineers in Water Resources Department as well as in other Departments and foreign bodies where Junior Engineers are working at present. Besides, the number of Junior Engineers for new field formations and Offices i.e. EIC P&D, C.E. D&R, C.E. Dam Safety, C.E. PPF, C.E. Investigation, C.E. OWPO, C.E. Water Service and CADPIM would also be made available. The respective strength of Junior Engineers in the field formations, other offices and the post in other Departments and foreign bodies to be filled up on deployment and deputation is indicated in the table below along-with reduction in strength mentioned in the remarks column.

As decided in the meeting with Chief Secretary 15% post of the Assistant Executive Engineers would be designated as Deputy Executive Engineers. e) **Executive Engineers -** It is proposed to increase the number of Divisions in Major & Medium Irrigation to 150 and create 6 Divisions for construction of megalifts. Besides, 30 number of posts would be provided for other Offices like EIC P&D, C.E. D&R, C.E. Dam Safety, C.E. PPF, C.E. Investigation, C.E. OWPO, C.E. Water Service and CADPIM and posts in other Department /Foreign Bodies would be reduced at the same level. It has also been proposed to create 8 Divisions under Minor Irrigation Wing and 4 Divisions under Mechanical Wing. The strength of Executive Engineers is given below.
